# **AHEAD OF THEIR TIME 2010**

## **11<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL AUSTIN-AREA ADVANCED STUDENT ART EXHIBITION**

This annual exhibition is organized by Arthouse to give advanced art students the opportunity to have their work exhibited in a professional setting and receive feedback from a well-respected curator. Each year an art professional from the Austin-area selects the work for this exhibition. Past jurors have included Elizabeth Dunbar, Curator at Arthouse at the Jones Center; Arturo Palacios, Director of Art Palace; Annette Carlozzi, Curator of American and Contemporary Art at The Blanton Museum of Art; and others.

The *Ahead of Their Time 2010* juror is Mary Mikel Stump. Mary Mikel Stump has served as Gallery Director at Texas State University since 1998, where she curates and organizes approximately twenty exhibitions a year, in addition to working with students and the larger University community. With a background both in studio art and architectural illustration/design, Stump brings multiple levels of working knowledge to her curatorial and creative practices. In addition, she has juried exhibitions, served on Arts Boards and Commissions, written critical reviews, and given lectures on a variety of issues in contemporary art.

Arthouse is currently engaged in the renovation and expansion of our building, the Jones Center. The expanded facility will enable Arthouse to have multiple, simultaneous exhibitions; include two studios for artists, critics, curators, writers, and scholars; and provide space for increased education and community events. Construction began in the fall of 2009 and the Jones Center will reopen in October 2010. For this reason, *Ahead of Their Time 2010* will take place in the gallery at the Pump Project Art Complex.

### **SCHEDULE**

*Ahead of Their Time 2010* will be on view May 1-8 at Pump Project Art Complex

April 1: Teachers and students notified of selected artwork

April 16: Selected work due to Pump Project Art Complex

April 24: Selected students receive portfolio reviews with juror

May 1, 2-4pm: Opening reception and award ceremony

May 8: Art Bash, annual teen celebration

### **CONFLICTS**

AP Portfolios are due on Friday, May 7. Artwork selected for *Ahead of Their Time 2010* must remain at Pump Project Art Complex from April 15 – May 9. Please keep this in mind when selecting work to submit to *Ahead of Their Time 2010*.

### **ARTIST ELIGIBILITY**

*Ahead of Their Time 2009* is open to high school advanced art students. At traditional schools, these are students who have taken art each year and are typically enrolled in an Art 3, Art 4, or an Advanced Placement class and are working on an AP portfolio. In nontraditional settings, students may have other experiences and coursework to show their art background and commitment.

## **MEDIA AND SPECIFICATIONS**

Students may submit up to 4 entries. Work in all media is eligible. Two-dimensional work must not exceed 72" in any dimension. If applicable, Arthouse will mat all artwork on archival white mat board and install each piece under Plexiglas. Work need not be completed as part of a class assignment. Work that has been shown previously at Arthouse may not be submitted.

## **ART MAY BE SUBMITTED IN THE FOLLOWING FORMATS:**

### **DIGITAL IMAGES**

Submit a CD containing JPEGs no larger than 1MB per image. Please submit 1 CD or DVD per teacher, per school. Label each CD or DVD with school and teacher name. Create a folder for each student. In the folder, label each JPEG with student's last name and the corresponding number on the entry form. If necessary, students may submit 2-3 digital images to show multiple views of a 3 dimensional work or details of a large 2 dimensional work. CDs must be accompanied by an entry form for each student.

### **FLAT COLOR PHOTOS**

Submit flat color photos in an 8 ½ x 11" format. Label images on the back with the corresponding number on the entry form, the title, the student's last name and first initial, and the school. Please indicate which direction is up with an arrow on the back.

### **VIDEOS, INSTALLATION, PERFORMANCE & TIME-BASED MEDIA**

For videos, please submit a DVD with the work. For media that cannot be fully represented with visual images, please include a proposal or description of the work of no more than 1 page.
